15 NIGHTS/16 DAYS



March 2 - 18, 2010
Departure/Arrival JFK International Airport

02 Mar. 2010: Depart JFK

03 Mar. 2010: Arrive Delhi

On arrival at Delhi, you are met and transferred to hotel.
(Overnight at hotel)

04 Mar. 2010: Drive Delhi to Agra - 240 kms/4 hrs. + Taj & Fort Visit

After breakfast at hotel drive to Agra and check in the hotel. Later visit the magnificent **Taj Mahal** - one of the Seven Wonders of the World surely the most extravagant expression of love ever created. 20,000 men labored for over 17 years to build this memorial to Shah Jahan's beloved wife. Also visit the **Red Fort** - the rusty and majestic red-sandstone fort of Agra stands on the banks of the river Yamuna. (Overnight at hotel)



05 Mar. 2010: Drive Agra to Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri - Approx. 250 kms / 6 hrs.

After breakfast at hotel drive to Jaipur en-route visit **Fatehpur Sikri** - built by the Mughal Emperor, Akbar in honor of Saint Salim Chisti, who foretold the birth of 3 sons to Emperor Akbar, an example of robust stability combined with originality. Each important edifice here represents a type by itself. Notable among them is the Diwane Khas, Punch Mahal, The Tomb of Salim Chisti, and the Buland Darwaza. Continue drive to Jaipur and check-in to hotel. (Overnight at hotel).

06 Mar. 2010: AM Amber + PM city tour

After breakfast excursion to Amber - the old capital of Jaipur rulers. Ride on the back of an elephant from the foots of the hill upto the gates of the fortress. Afternoon sight seeing tour of Jaipur including Maharaja's Museum and Jai Singh's Astronomical Observatory and Hawa Mahal. (Overnight at hotel)



07 Mar. 2010: Jaipur

Breakfast at hotel, then after day is free to explore the market area for shopping purpose. (Overnight at hotel)

08 Mar. 2010: Drive Jaipur to Delhi

Morning at leisure. Afternoon drive to Delhi and check into hotel. (Overnight at hotel)



09 Mar. 2010 : Drive Delhi to Haridwar - 210 kms/4 hrs.

After breakfast at hotel drive to Haridwar

10 - 14 Mar. 2010 : Haridwar

We will be staying at Shree **Ma Yogashakti Divyadham Trust**, which is our Haridwar Ashram, where we will be able to experience the wonders of daily life in India. We will also enjoy special daily programs, such as morning aarti, satsang, yoga and dips in the Ganges from ghats across the street of the ashram.



Haridwar is a city of 400 Temples and is on the banks of the Holy River Ganges. We will go to Hari-ki-Puri to attend evening aarti; when leaf boats are filed with flowers, lit with lamps and set adrift on the Ganges.

Hari-ki-Puri is named after a supposed imprint of Vishnu's feet, We will visit Mansa Devi Temple and other holy places in Haridwar.



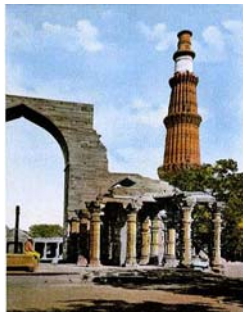
From our home base of Haridwar we will have excursions to **Rishikesh** the city of many ashrams to take some classes in yoga and philosophy .

15 Mar. 2010: Drive Haridwar to Delhi - 250 kms/6 hrs.

After breakfast we drive to Delhi and check in the hotel. (Overnight at hotel)

16 Mar. 2010: AM Akshardham Temple + PM Free

After breakfast at hotel, Morning is at leisure or visiting market places on your own for shopping purpose. Evening proceed to visit the Akshardham Temple - Tour the massive mega Akshardham Temple Complex in Delhi, India and explore an amazing world of Indian culture ornate with 20, 000 statues, floral motifs, arches and exquisitely carved pillars. The magnificent Akshardham Temple in Delhi has been constructed under the patronage of the Bochasanvasi Aksharapurushottam Swaminarayan Sanstha (BAPS) and was inaugurated on November 7, 2005. Evening return back to hotel. (Overnight at hotel)



17 Mar. 2010: Delhi Sightseeing

After breakfast proceed for sightseeing tour of Old Delhi visiting the Raj Ghat, the site where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated; Jama Masjid - the largest mosque in India; and the Red Fort - once the most opulent fort and palace of the Moghul Empire. In the afternoon take a sightseeing tour of New Delhi visiting the Humayun's Tomb, the Qutub Minar. Drive along the ceremonial avenue - Rajpath, past the imposing India Gate, Parliament House and the President's Residence. In the evening hours check out from the hotel and transferred to International airport for your flight.

18 Mar. 2010 : Depart Delhi

In time transfer to Delhi airport for your flight to back home.
